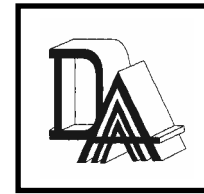

The Detroit Area Agency on Aging (DAAA) is a private, non-profit agency founded in 1980. It makes a variety of services available to older adults and their families through public and private funding. Services are provided to individuals age 60 years and older who reside in the City of Detroit, Hamtramck, Harper Woods, Highland Park, Grosse Pointe, Grosse Pointe Farms, Grosse Pointe Park, Grosse Pointe Shores, and Grosse Pointe Woods.

DAAA offers Care Management Services to eligible, frail and homebound seniors through nurse and social work teams, who locate, mobilize and monitor home services needed to support independent living in the community. In order to be considered for Care Management Services, contact the Centralized Information and Referral Assistance (CIRA) Unit of the Detroit Area Agency on Aging. The CIRA Unit assists seniors, caregivers, disabled adults, and health care providers to locate supportive services and long term care resources in Southeast Michigan. **To obtain information on programs and referral assistance for Care Management Services and other support services in the community, call the DAAA at (313) 446-4444 and ask to be connected to the CIRA (or Information & Assistance) Unit.** The CIRA Unit's Information & Assistance (I&A) Specialists are available Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. A voice mail message may be left after workweek hours; just leave a brief message with your name and phone number and we will return your call in the order it was received.

The care management services available through the DAAA include:

- (1) **Detroit Area MI Choice Program (Medicaid Waiver Program)** This program makes home and community services available to individuals over the age of 18 years who are also eligible for Medicaid. Services may include in-home support, adult day care, respite care, nutrition, durable medical equipment, counseling, and other support programs.

Eligibility Guidelines

- Disabled adults (age 18 – 64) *or* frail seniors (age 65 and older)
- Individuals currently receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Individuals who would be eligible for Medicaid if they were in a nursing home, or whom are already receiving Medicaid for other reasons
- Residents in the City of Detroit, five Grosse Pointes, Hamtramck, Harper Woods, or Highland Park
- Frail or disabled individuals, having multiple healthcare and social support needs
- Limited financial resources available to pay for care (gross income is at or below 300% of the SSI level - \$1,911 or less per person per month and assets under \$2,000 per person)
- Nursing Home eligible, but considering alternative long-term care options.

AGING NETWORK PROGRAM & SERVICES

- (2) **Project CHOICE (Care Management)** This program is also designed to locate, mobilize and manage a variety of home care and support services needed by eligible frail seniors, whom without these services and support, would likely require placement in nursing homes or other long-term care institutions.

Eligibility Guidelines

- Frail or disabled individuals, age 60 or older
- Residents in the City of Detroit, five Grosse Pointes, Hamtramck, Harper Woods, or Highland Park
- Limited financial resources, but not eligible for the *Detroit Area MI Choice* Medicaid Waiver Program
- Determined medically eligible for placement into a basic or skilled-care nursing or foster-care facility; *or*
- Functionally unable to provide self-care without assistance due to illness or declining health and without sufficient support for meeting needs; *or*
- Multiple, complex, and diverse needs; *or*
- Resides in a skilled or intermediate facility or other institution and no longer requires that level of care, but is unable to obtain needed community services to return home., having multiple healthcare and social support needs

INFORMATION & REFERRAL ASSISTANCE

The Centralized Information & Referral Assistance (CIRA) Unit of the Detroit Area Agency on Aging helps seniors, disabled adults, healthcare providers, and caregivers locate support services and long term care resources in southeast Michigan. Persons can call the agency and have their questions personally answered by an Information & Assistance (I&A) Specialist. This is a free service provided by the DAAA for the community.

Simply call (313) 446-4444 and ask to be connected to the CIRA (or Information and Assistance) Unit. Please note, that an I&R Operator may need to ask you for personal information (Social Security Number, insurance identification, financial income, and home support information) in order to be able to provide assistance with referrals to some specific Federal and State supported programs. All discussions with callers and referral assistance information will remain confidential.

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Definition: *A program designed to find, mobilize and coordinate a variety of home care and other services needed by frail, homebound elderly persons age 60 years and older at "high-risk" of entering a nursing home. The goals of this program are to help the frail, older person remain independent by helping him/her arrange for formal and informal services in order to prevent premature admission to a nursing home or other institution.*
